
Suggested Reading:



Summer Reading for Young Adults

Grades 6-12

Read 30 minutes a day for a total of 210 minutes a week from June 6 through July 31. It's okay if you can't do it all in one day. You can read more on one day and less on another. These books can be anything you enjoy: fiction, non-fiction, graphic novels, manga, or audio books (either a physical copy or e-copy). Prizes will be given weekly for participants and then entered in a drawing for grand prizes! If you read more than 210 minutes a week you will get a bonus prize at the end (no matter if it's one minute over or 100 minutes over). 
