The Hillside Walgreens is having a shot clinic at the Hillside Public Library. Walgreens will bill your insurance company. If anyone needs to pay cash price, the cost will be \$25.99. Walgreens will have a limited number of flu shot vouchers that can be used to help anyone that does not have insurance. Also available, will be Pneumonia vaccines for anyone that is eligible, as determined by CDC guidelines.

Attendees, please bring any MEDICAL AND/OR PRESCRIPTION insurance cards that you may have including Medicare B ("red, white and blue") cards.

Please note that the Hillside Walgreens is participating in the "Get a shot, Give a Shot" campaign again in which Walgreens contributes a portion of each shot to the United Nations Foundation! Walk-Ins will be welcome but it is best to register for a time slot. You may call the library to register.
